### Animation Academy

July 24–August 4

Through our rigorous project-based curriculum, students will be introduced to the fundamental principles of animation and learn about the artistic and technical skills needed to create high-quality animation for film, games, and visual effects.

### Art & Design Portfolio Course (Credit-bearing)

July 8–23

### Audio Engineering, Sound Design & Music Academy

July 24–August 4
